2021 Annual Pass Rules & Regulations

PREAMBLE

These Rules and Regulations have been established by OGA Golf Course to protect the Course Facilities and to promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment of the Pass Holders, their families, guests and all other persons using the Course Facilities. OGA Golf Course may amend these Rules and Regulations at any time.

ANNUAL PASS CLASSIFICATIONS

1. 7 Day Pass Holder | 12-month access to green fees and practice facilities Monday – Sunday (When space is available, Holidays included)
2. 5 Day Pass Holder | 12-month access to golf course and practice facilities Monday – Friday (When space is available, Holidays NOT included)
3. Snowbird Pass Holder | 6-month access to golf course and practice facilities Monday – Friday (When space is available, Holidays NOT included)
4. Unlimited Cart Usage | Unlimited cart usage expires on the same date as Annual Pass. Cart usage is good ONLY for the Pass Holder. Guests of Annual Pass Holders must pay for ½ cart rental each time they play.
5. Trail Fee | All Pass Holders who own and use a personal golf cart at OGA Golf Course must pay the Trail Fee.

GENERAL FACILITY RULES

1. Pass Holders, their families and their guests shall abide by all rules and regulations of OGA Golf Course as they may be amended at any time.
2. All food and beverages consumed on the Course Facilities must be furnished by OGA Golf Course unless otherwise permitted. All alcohol consumed on property MUST be purchased onsite at Orchards Grill.
3. Pass Holders shall not use the roster list of the Pass Holders at OGA Golf Course for solicitation or commercial purposes.
4. Any complaints, criticisms, or suggestions of any kind relating to any of the operations of the Course or its associates, must be addressed to the MOD (Manager on Duty) or may be in writing, signed, and addressed to the Head Golf Professional. Email is the preferred form of initial communication.
5. Smoking/ Vaping is not permitted in any enclosed areas on the course property

GENERAL GOLF COURSE RULES

1. The Rules of Golf together with the Rules of Etiquette shall be the rules of the OGA Golf Course, except where local rules apply.
2. "Cutting-in" is not permitted at any time. Holes are to be played in sequential order. Permission to pass a group or skip holes must be obtained from the group in question, the host, or the Golf Shop. All players must check in with the GOLF SHOP prior to starting play. Under no circumstances are players permitted to start play under their own volition. Disciplinary action will be taken against any pass holder who violates this policy.
3. Twosomes may play at the discretion of the golf shop. Twosomes should not expect to play through foursomes and should not exert any pressure on the groups ahead. Foursomes always have the right of way.
4. Twosomes and singles shall be grouped with other players, if available, at the discretion of the golf shop.
5. Twosomes and singles have no priority on the golf course in relation to pace of play and shall be permitted to play only at the discretion of the Manager on Duty.
6. Speed of play: It is the goal of all players to complete their round in no more than 4 hours 20 minutes. This amount of time is more than adequate, provided all players remain aware of the rights of others to play without delay. It is the responsibility of each group to keep pace with the group ahead. It is each group's responsibility to be observant of its position on the course and keep pace.
7. Repair all ball marks on the greens.
8. Repair all divots with the provided sand on the golf carts.
9. Enter and leave bunkers at their shallowest point of access. Never walk up or down steep bunker faces when entering or leaving a bunker. Smooth sand over with a rake upon leaving. Please leave rakes outside the perimeter of the bunker, away from the most likely lines of play.
10. Practice is not allowed on the golf courses. The practice facilities should be used for all practice.

11. All players who stop after playing nine holes for any reason must occupy the next tee before the following players arrive at the tee or they shall lose their position on the golf course and must get permission from the Golf Shop to resume play.
12. Searching for golf balls other than those played by players in your group is not allowed on the course at any time.
13. Reasonable golf attire is required for all passholders and their guests
14. If lightning is in the area, golfers are responsible for their own safety.
15. Jogging, walking, or biking on any of the cart paths is not permitted at any time.
16. No beverage coolers are permitted on the course unless provided by the Course.
17. No glass bottled beverages are allowed on the course at any time.
18. Groups of five or more players may only be allowed with the permission of the Head Golf Professional
19. Cell phones are permitted on the golf course. Please be respectful of others when using your phone or playing music.

TEE TIMES

1. All players must have a tee time reserved through the golf shop, via phone, or online. Tee Times are available to all Annual Pass Holders up to 7 days in advance. The Golf Shop must approve any changes to a tee time.
2. Pass holders should notify the golf shop of any cancellation at least 24 hours prior to your tee time. Failure to cancel a tee time OR short-showing a tee time will result in an automatic charge of the green fees to the credit card saved on file.

REGISTRATION

1. All pass holders and their guests must check-in with the Golf Shop Staff before beginning play.
2. Failure to check in and register ten minutes prior to a reserved starting time may result in assignment of another tee time or cancellation at the discretion of the starter.

GENERAL GOLF CART RULES

1. Golf carts may only be operated by persons at least 18 years of age having a valid automobile driver's license
2. Only two persons and two sets of golf clubs are permitted per golf cart.
3. Obey all golf cart traffic and daily conditions signs. Riding on back of golf cart is strictly prohibited.
4. **All golf carts must stay on the cart paths near teeing grounds and putting greens, no exceptions.**
5. Golf carts are prohibited from entering hazards, penalty areas, and no play zones.
- 6 Each pass holder accepts and assumes all responsibility for liability connected with the operation of the golf carts.

DISCIPLINE

1. Pass Holders are responsible for their own conduct and for the conduct of their family and guests. Any Pass Holder whose conduct or whose family's or guest's conduct is deemed by OGA Golf Course to likely endanger the welfare, safety, harmony, or good reputation of the Course or its patrons, or is otherwise improper, may be reprimanded, fined, suspended, or expelled from the Course and have all privileges associated with the Pass suspended or terminated by the Course. The Course shall also be the sole judge of what constitutes improper conduct, but improper conduct may include any of the following: failure to meet eligibility for being a Pass Holder, submitting false information on the Pass Application, failing to pay any of the amount owed to the OGA Golf Course in a proper and timely manner, failing to abide by the Rules and Regulations as established by the Course from time to time, abusing Course personnel or associates, acting in a manner incompatible with the standard of conduct which would likely injure the reputation of the Pass Holders of OGA Golf Course.
2. OGA Golf Course reserves the right to restrict or suspend some or all of a Pass Holder's, Members, their family's and or guest's Course privileges. No Pass Holder may, on account of any restriction or suspension, be entitled to any refund of Annual Pass Holder annual or monthly fees, or any other fees.
3. Reinstatement of a Pass will be at the sole discretion of the Director of Operations

LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY OR INSTANCES OF PERSONAL INJURY

1. Each Pass Holder, as a condition of his/her Pass, and each guest, as a condition of invitation to the Course Facilities, assume sole responsibility for his or her property. OGA Golf Course shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any private property used or stored on the Course Facilities.
2. Every Pass Holder of the Course is responsible for his or her own well-being as well as the well-being of all guests while using the Course facilities. Any action resulting in personal injury shall not be the responsibility of the Course for any reason.
3. Every Pass Holder of the Course shall be liable for any property damage caused by the Pass Holder, any guest, or any family member. The cost of such damage shall be charged to the responsible Pass Holder's credit card on file.

GUEST PRIVILEGES

1. Guest privileges may be extended under the rules established by OGA Golf Course.
2. Guest privileges may be denied, limited, withdrawn, or revoked at any time for reasons considered sufficient by the Course.
3. All guest fees are due upon day of play. Accompanied guests of Annual Pass Holders will receive the applicable OGA member rate.

CONTACT INFORMATION

1. Each Pass Holder shall be responsible for filing with the Manager on Duty, in writing, his or her contact information and any changes thereto where the Pass Holder wishes all correspondence from the Course to be sent.
2. The Manager on Duty must be notified in writing of any change of contact information. Failure to do so shall constitute a waiver of the right to receive OGAGC notices, e-mails, and other communications. Email is the primary contact vehicle that OGA Golf Course uses.

HANDICAPS

1. Handicaps are administered by the respective OGAGC Men's & Women's Clubs.

GRATUITIES

1. For exemplary services, gratuities are welcomed for our outside player services staff or any other staff members at OGA Golf Course.

CHILDREN

1. Unless permitted by OGA Golf Course, children under 12 years of age are not allowed at the Course Facilities unless accompanied and supervised by an adult.
2. Pass Holders are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children when enjoying the Course Facilities.
3. Children ages 17 and under can be added to any existing Annual Pass for \$200 per child

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Pass Holders/guests using the golf course should do their part to make a round of golf a pleasant experience for everyone at the Course. Please follow these suggestions:

1. Do not waste time. Anticipate the club or clubs you may need and go directly to your ball. Always be near your ball to play promptly when it is your turn. OGA Golf Course management requests that all players play "ready golf".
2. The time required to "hole out" on and around the green is a chief cause of slow play. Study and clear the line of your putt while others are doing the same. Be ready to putt when it is your turn.
3. When approaching a green, park your golf cart on the cart path on the best direct line to the next tee in order to save significant time. Never leave the golf cart in front of the green where you will have to retrace your steps and get it while the following players wait for you to move on.
4. When play of a hole is completed, leave the green promptly and proceed to the next tee without delay. Record the scoring for the completed hole while the others in your group are playing from the next tee.
